

TEACHER SECTION RATIO

The following formula for calculating the overall strength of teachers in each school may be considered as a guideline

$$\text{No. of Teachers} = \frac{\text{No. of Sections} \times \text{no of Teaching Periods per week}}{32 \text{ (Teaching load per teacher per week)}}$$

Besides the Principal and Vice Principal, the school academic staff will be worked out as per above formula in respect of the following categories of staff:-

Post-graduate Teachers	One per subject depending upon the teaching load.	For subjects taught at the plus 2 stage.
Trained Graduate Teachers	One per subject (subject to the total not exceeding two teachers per section).	For classes VI to X
Special Educator TGT/PRT	One per School @ one for every 40 students (needing special education) or part thereof.	For Inclusive Education.
Computer Science Teacher in TGT Grade	One per 15 Sections or part thereof	For Classes VI to X and for upgrading IT skills of teachers.
Primary Teachers	1.5 Teacher per Section	For Classes I to V.
Computer Science Teacher in PRT Grade	One per 15 Sections or part thereof.	For Classes I to V, wherever required and for upgrading IT skills of teachers.
Asst Teacher	One per Section	For Classes I & II only.
Teachers for Art & Craft, Music, Dance, Yoga and PET	At least one per subject depending upon the workload. The overall authorization for different classes will not exceed the laid down scales. Maximum up to 1.5 per class for Primary Classes.	Common for the whole school.
